

Moving glioblastoma from terminal to treatable, powered by patients

OurBrainBank is a patient-led movement designed to move glioblastoma (GBM), the deadliest type of brain tumor, from terminal to treatable. We're on a mission to support, inform, and empower every person with GBM and their loved one. We're the first non-profit created by, for, and with people with GBM, and the only GBM-focused non-profit conducting patient/carer-led data collection and research.

OurBrainBank's founder, Jessica Morris (1963-2021), survived for five years after her GBM diagnosis — only 5% of people do. She knew more data was needed to tackle this terrible disease. We continue to build on her vision today as new and better treatments are still urgently needed. Our goal is to give GBM patients a voice — in clinical trials, research, and at all stages of treatment.

## **Data and Community: Pilot Study and Next Steps**

In 2018, OurBrainBank launched its pilot glioblastoma study using a free smartphone app that patients or care partners used to track health indicators, play neurological games, and more. The success of the pilot study demonstrated that people living with GBM would contribute health data to a central database using mobile technology.

### Milestones:

- 2018: Fabio Iwamoto, MD et al presented a poster about the pilot study at the Society for Neuro-Oncology conference
- 2019: OurBrainBank published "The Potential of Patient Power"
- 2021: "Pilot study of smartphone-based health outcome tracking (OurBrainBank) for glioblastoma patients" published in the journal Neuro-Oncology Practice In 2021, OurBrainBank closed the pilot study and researched new technologies to continue to harness the power of patients both by collecting data and helping people day-to-day. Our goal: accelerate research for tomorrow and improve the outcomes and quality of life of people living with GBM.

### Our achievements in 2022 and ambitions for 2023

We have supercharged our outreach to patients and caregivers to make sure that when they receive that first terrifying diagnosis they are not alone. Our soon-to-be launched upgraded website will provide information and support, and act as a hub where together we can push for more resources and attention for this often-forgotten cancer.

We are fueling cutting-edge research with neuroscientists at Harvard University to expand our data collection effort and enhance understanding of the disease and its impact on families, building on our pilot study.

We are launching advocacy campaigns to make our groundbreaking GBM Bill of Rights a reality.

We are connecting different healthcare systems and approaches to expand our international reach, with a very active presence in the UK.

OurBrainBank staff created custom graphics to share on social media.






### **OurBrainBank at SNO**

## **Clinical Trial using AI for Precision Trial Matching**

In our GBM Bill of Rights, #1 is the Right to Personalized Care.

If you (or a loved one) is considering a GBM clinical trial, this trial <u>offers the option to use Al</u> (artificial intelligence) to analyze your EHR (electronic health record) to match your unique case with potentially effective trials.

This study is not only for GBM, but all solid tumors. It's open to pediatric and adult patients globally. You don't need to travel to participate, although the trials recommended may be at different treatment center.
